This program provides an opportunity for upperclassman to gain work experience while supporting our Nation's Navy and Marine Corps.

Benefits

- Hands on experience through summer and holiday work at NAWCAD (640 hours minimum, salaries starting at \$14.59/hour).
- Potential paid tuition up to \$5200 per semester and possible book reimbursement of up to \$600 per semester.
- Potential employment upon successful graduation and completion of all Pathway Program requirements.

Requirements

- Candidates must have been accepted for enrollment, or are enrolled and seeking a degree in a qualifying educational institution on a full-time basis.
- Acceptance into the NAWCAD's Pathway Program. (Application is made to a Pathways Vacancy Announcement in USAJOBS.)
- US Citizenship. 18 years of age or older.
- A student who receives tuition reimbursement in the intern program incurs a service obligation for Federal Civil Service employment.
